Sneak Peak into the Program

With the **Building Units**, different building systems of sustainable architecture such as compost toilets or clay stoves are discussed and put into practice. These workshops are accompanied by the expert engineer Lehel Horvat as well as the architects Dragana Kojicic and Andrea Sabo.

In the **Culture Points** we want to explore with you how it is possible to combine nature with art and create a cultural centre in the countryside.

The **Group Games** are the playful bonding agent of the two program points. Next to games from the theatre world or Capture The Flag matches in the forest we will encounter the cultural differences and similarities of both countries.

Re-Creative Islands round off the offer. Here, the adjacent forest, the nearby lake, or the easily accessible city of Novi Sad are of importance. This time can be freely arranged in creative, recreational and social terms.
